Program Beginnings

- 1998 Mayor Howard Peak and other Council members initiated and supported idea of creating linear parks along San Antonio creekways.
- 1999 Program plan was developed, focused around San Antonio River, Salado Creek and Leon Creek
- 2000 First Sales Tax Initiative passed by voters to provide \$20m
- 2022 Greenways funded through 2022 Bond.





Program Mission & Goals

Mission:

To enhance the quality of life for San Antonio residents and visitors

Goals:

- Expand recreational opportunities and park access
- Preserve open space and riparian connectivity for wildlife habitat
- Building blocks for pedestrian and bicycle connectivity
- Increase creekway access for stormwater management







Design Objectives

User Friendliness & Safety

- ADA accessible concrete trails (width varies)
- Signage, mile markers, flood warnings
- Connections to neighborhoods and other destinations
- Trailhead locations convenient to residents
- Operating Hours sunrise to sunset

Environmental Sustainability


- Protection of Riparian Habitat
- Low Impact Development (LID) principals
- Native landscape materials
- Preserve tree canopy and geology
- Alleviate dumping and off-roading
- Removal of invasive species





HWP Greenway Trails Program Accomplishments

- Approximately 101 miles of trail completed
- Over 1,650 acres of creekway lands acquired to date
- 31 miles of trail in design and construction
- 25 additional miles planned in partnership with Bexar County







Greenway System Management

- Public Safety
 - Park Police Bike & ATV patrol
 - Trail Stewards
 - Trail Watch Volunteers
- Park Operations
 - Ongoing trail and park land maintenance
- Stormwater Operations
 - Ongoing removal of trash and debris to facilitate drainage (5year cycle)
