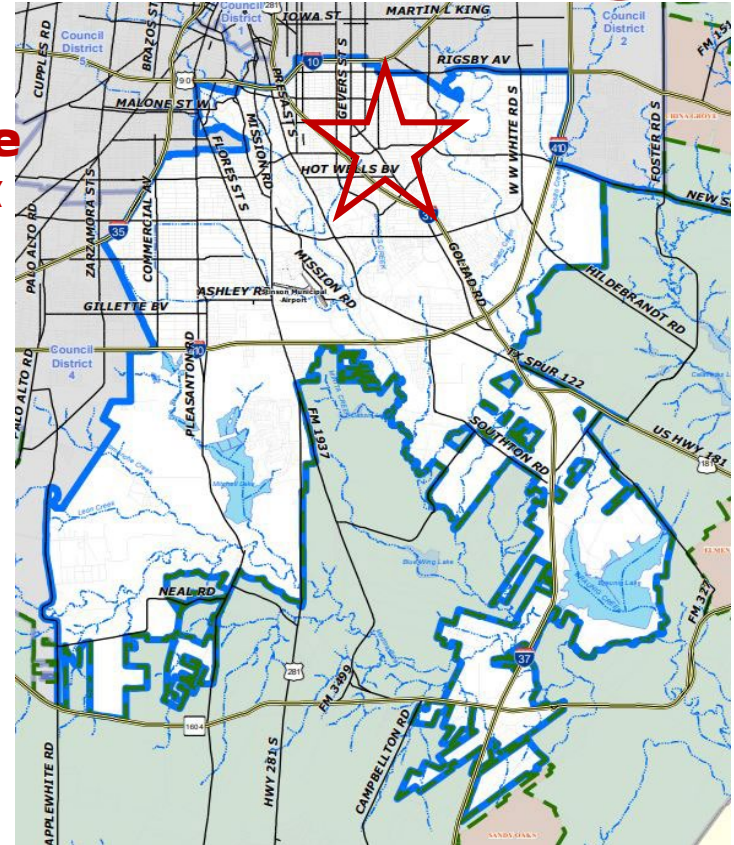

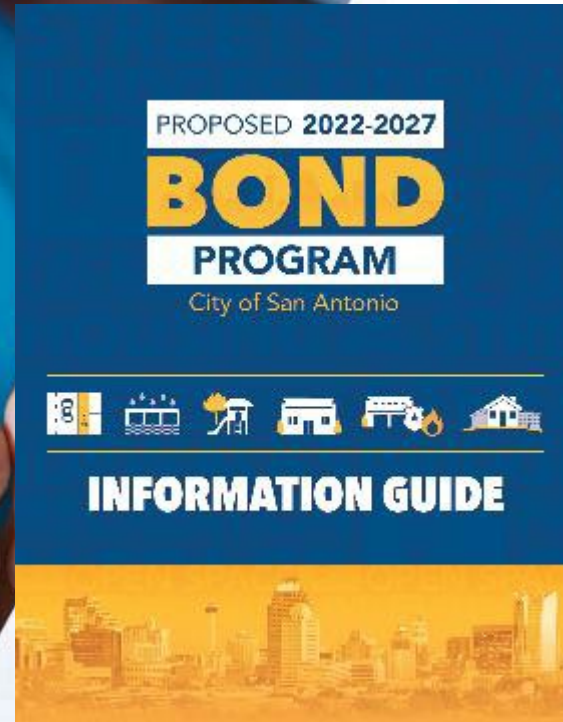

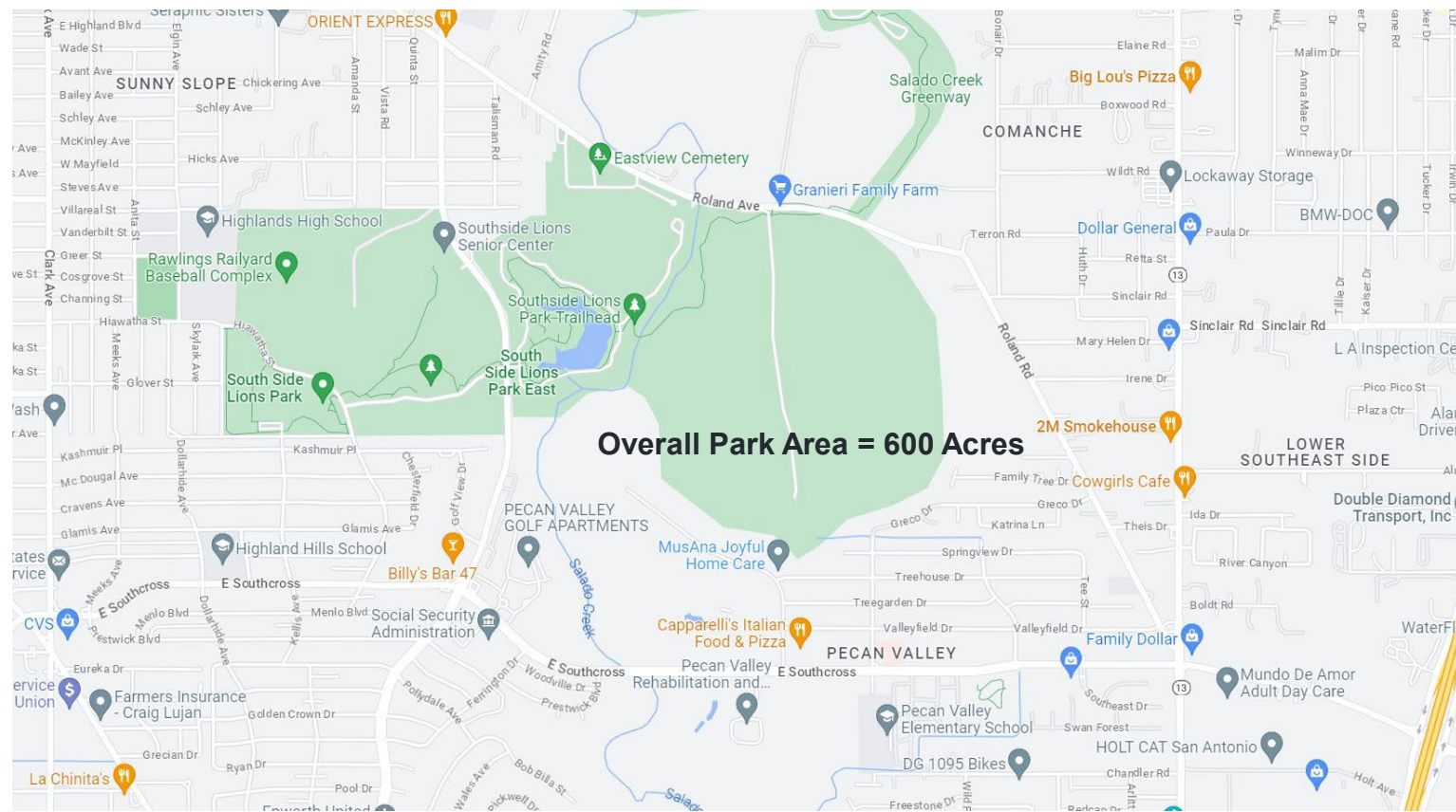
“Construct general park improvements within available funding which may include a shaded playground, splash pad, and other recreational amenities”

- Overall Funding for \$1,250,000 total for all costs, hard & soft (Improvements, Engineering, Design, Permits, Environmental, etc.)

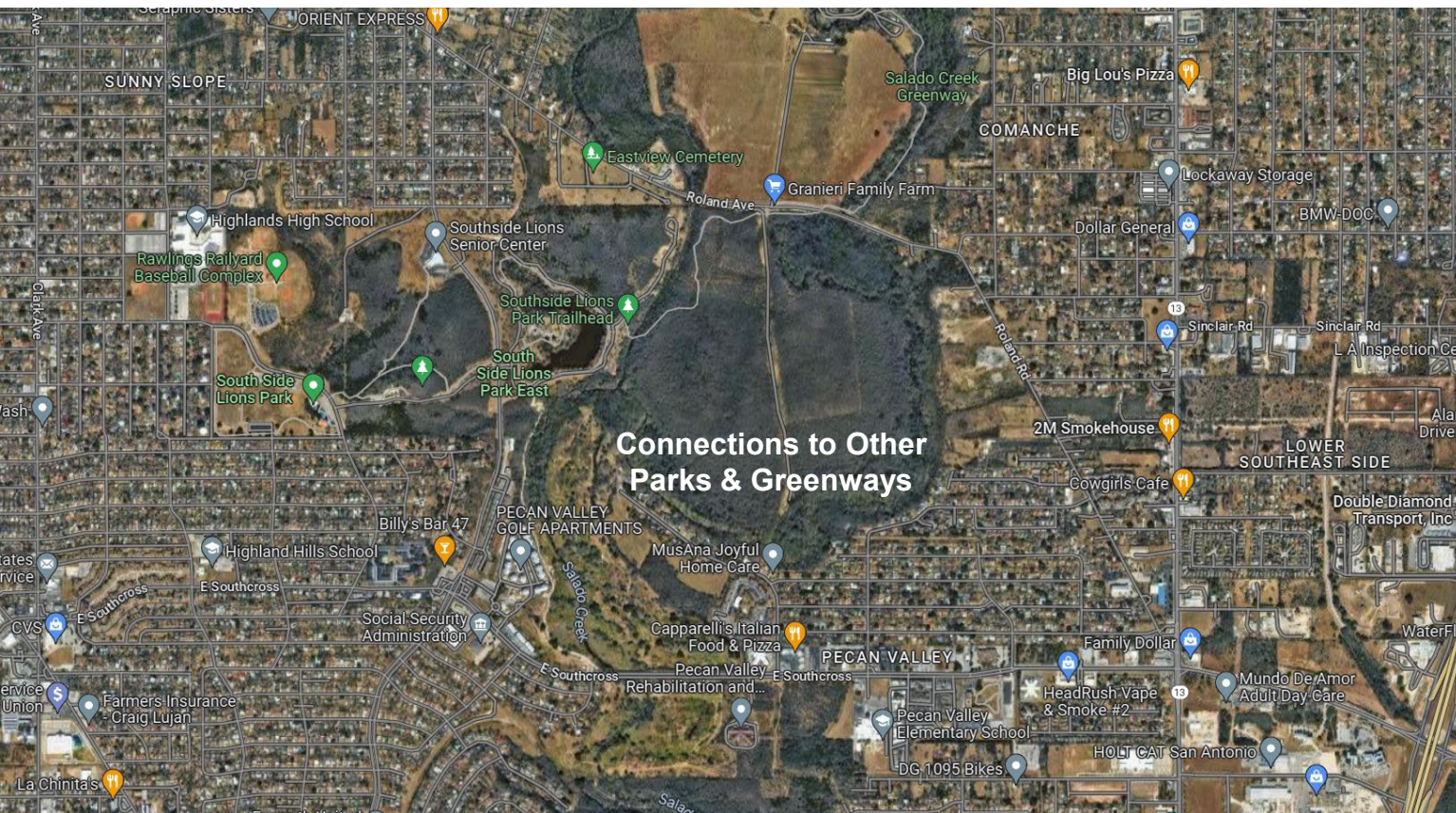

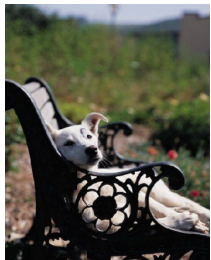
