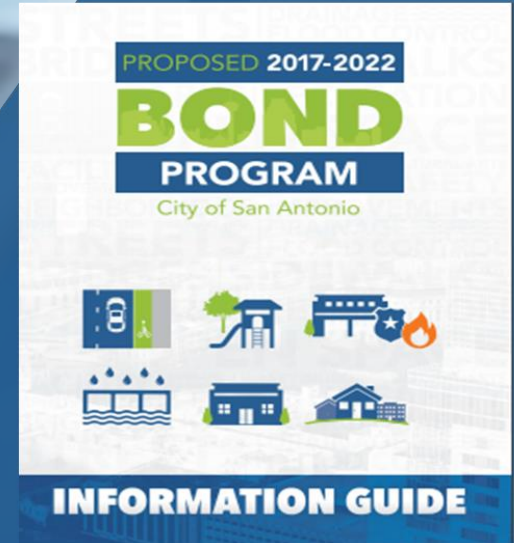

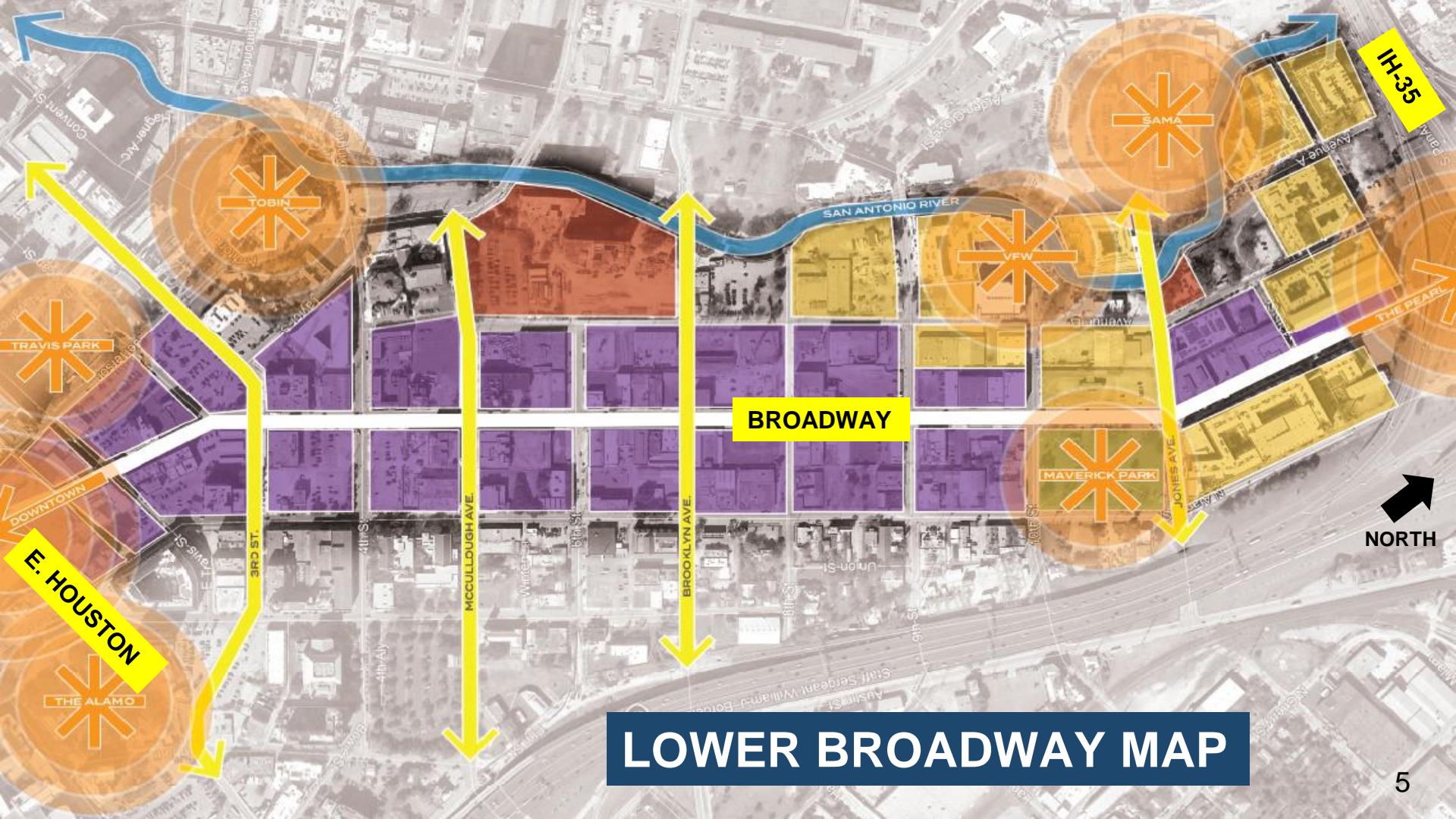

Broadway Corridor:

- Old roadway and pavement markings
- Broken and cracked sidewalks
- Non-compliant wheelchair ramps
- Lighting upgrades needed

Project Information

Proposed Improvements

- Utility underground conversion at side streets, CPS electric, telecom upgrades/adjustments, 5G network, water and sewer
- Roadway reconstruction
- Curbs, sidewalks and driveway approaches
- ADA compliant wheelchair ramps
- Drainage



- Pedestrian amenities, lighting and streetscape
- Landscaping – Low Impact Development (Green Infrastructure)
- On-street parking
- Wide sidewalks – 8FT min. with 11FT to 17FT range
- Traffic signal upgrades

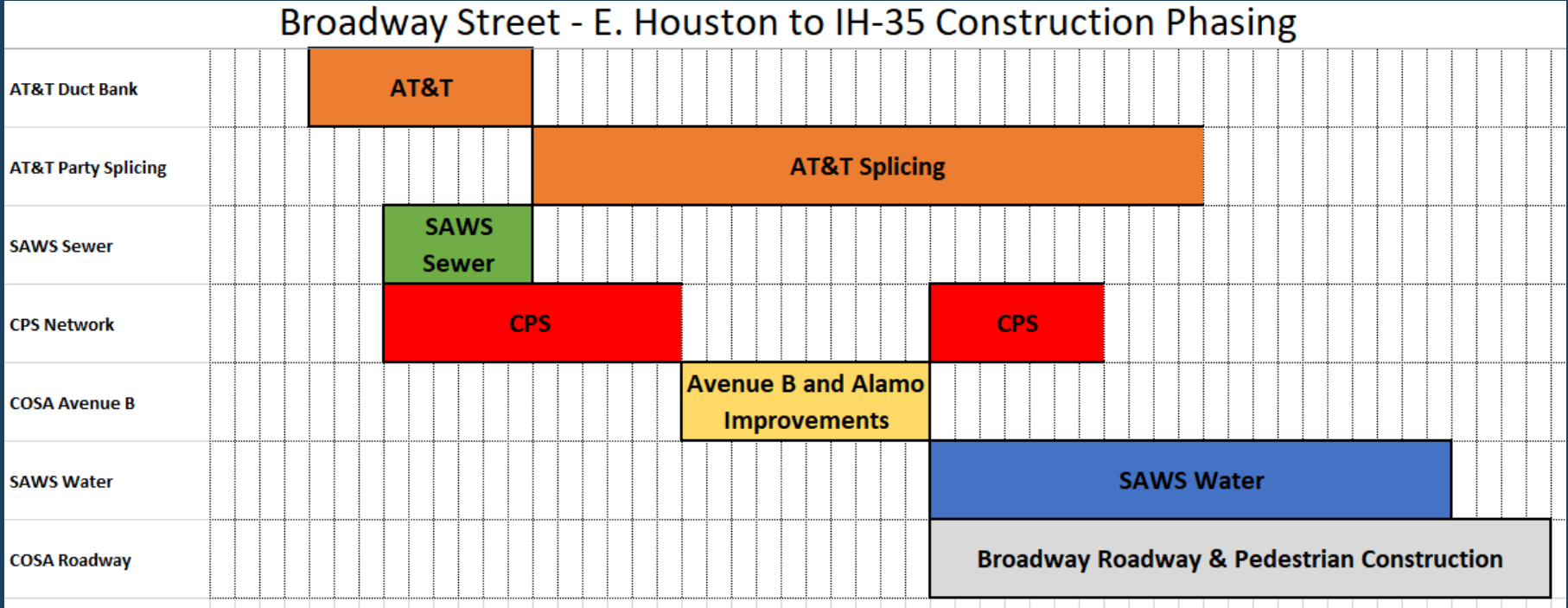

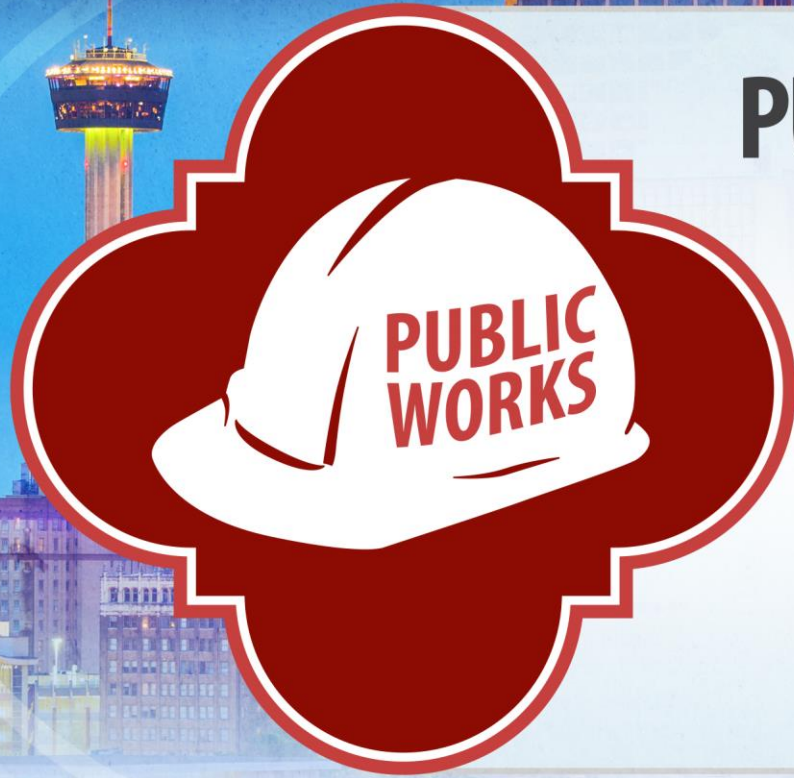

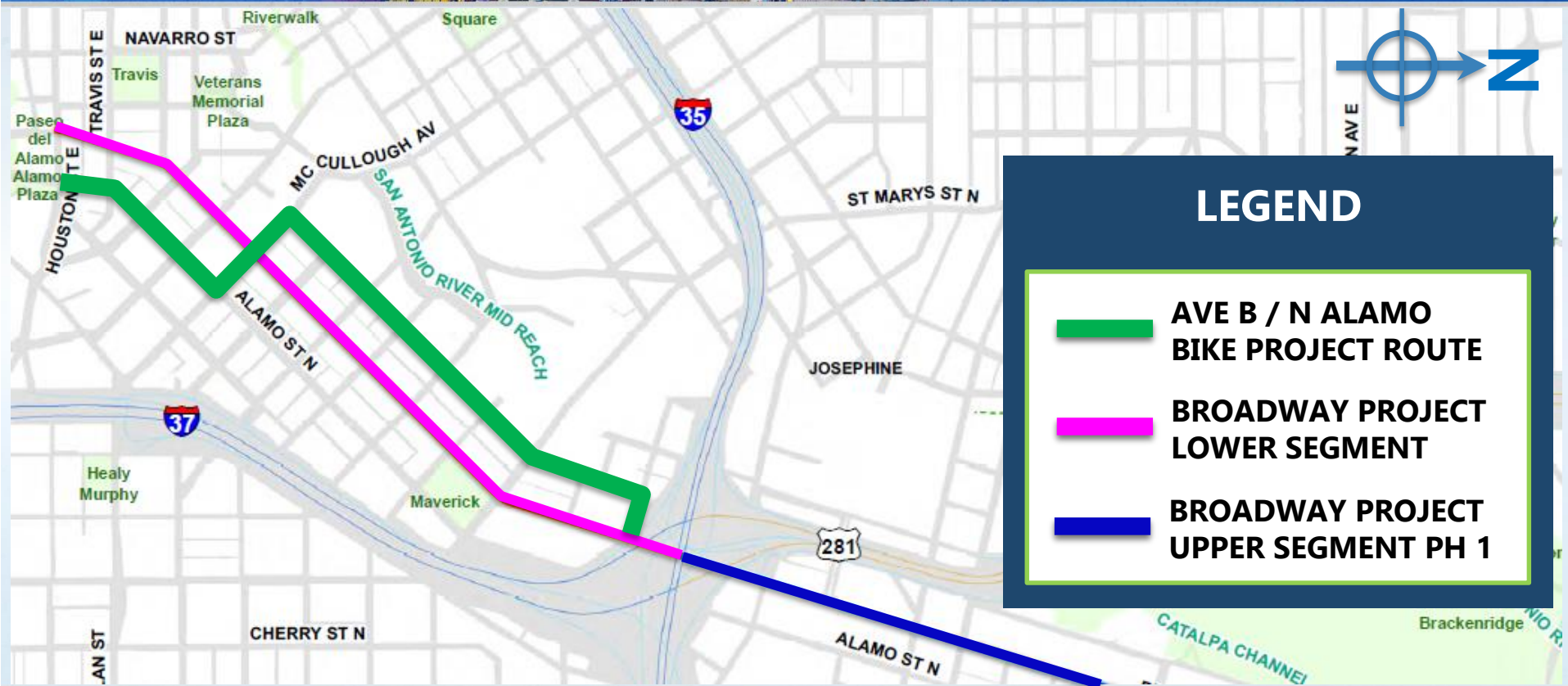
AVENUE B BIKE LANE CONCEPTUALIZATION PROPOSED CONDITIONS
